Every time Jesus is called, "LORD," in the New Testament, it is a reference to Him being the God of the Old Testament.

Saved -

Born Again -

Regenerated -

Quickened -

Cleansed -

Redeemed -

CONVERTED -

Forgiven -

There is a simplicity that is in Christ.

2 Cor 11:2-4 *For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.*

3 *But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the **SIMPLICITY** that is in Christ.*

4 *For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.*

The Christian life is hard because it requires character but it is not so complex that someone cannot understand it.

Jesus said knowing for sure that you were on your way to Heaven was easy enough to for a child to understand.

If salvation is a system then it becomes as complex as that system.

If salvation is a church then it becomes as complicated as that church

If salvation is a religion then it becomes as complicated as that religion.

Salvation is not a system or a church or a religion.

Salvation is a person - Jesus Christ.

John 14:6 *Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.*

1 Jn 5:12 *He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.*

What does the Bible say about it's Contents and Jesus

Acts 10:43 *To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.*

Isa 53:11 *He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.*

Jer 31:34 *And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.*

Dan 9:24 *Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.*

Micah 7:18-20 *Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.*

19 *He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.*

20 *Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.*

Zech 13:1 *In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.*

Mal 4:2 *But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.*

1 Pet 1:9-11 *Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.*

10 *Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:*

11 *Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.*

What did Jesus say about the O.T.

Luke 24:25-27 *Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:*

26 *Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?*

27 *And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.*

Luke 24:44-45 *And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.*

45 *Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,*

John 1:45 *Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.*

John 5:39 *Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.*

John 5:46 *For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me.*

Acts 26:22-23 *Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come:*

23 *That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.*

Acts 13:38-39 *Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:*

39 *And by him **all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law** of Moses.*

Where is Jesus and what is known of Him in the O.T.

Heb 1:1 *God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,
divers manners - diverse portions*

Gen 3:15 *And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt
bruise his heel.
Seed of the woman*

Gen 12:3 *And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.
Messiah would come through Abraham.*

Gen 15:6 *And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.*

Rom 4:3 *For what saith the scripture? **Abraham believed God**, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.*

Gen 49:10 *The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering
of the people be.
Messiah would belong to the Tribe of Judah*

Ps 22:1 *My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?
Some of the words on the cross were known*

Ps 22:7-8 *All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,
8 He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.
What people would say to Jesus Christ on the cross was told*

Ps 22:14-18 *I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my
bowels.
15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into
the dust of death.
16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my
feet.
17 I may tell all my bones: they look and stare upon me.
18 They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.
His joints being out of joint from the impact of dropping the cross in the ground
The piercing of the hands of feet
What they would do with Jesus clothing was known*

Ps 16:9-11 *Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.
10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy;
at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.
The Resurrection was told about*

Ps 129:2-3 *Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: yet they have not prevailed against me.
3 The plowers plowed upon my back: they made long their furrows.
A graphic description of the scourging*

Ps 132:11 *The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.
Christ should be of David's family*

Dan 9:26 *And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall
come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war
desolations are determined.
When Christ would be cut-off or put to death*

Isa 53:9-12

And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

10 *Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.*

11 *He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.*

12 *Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.*

Die for the sins of the people, numbered with the transgressors, pray for those who put Him to death

Isa 50:6 *I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.*
More of the scourging

Isa 52:13-14 *Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high.*

14 *As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:*

Isa 7:14

Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

The virgin birth

Isa 9:6-7

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

7 *Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.*

He would be God Almighty in the flesh

Isa 42:1-3

Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.

2 *He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street.*

3 *A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.*

The character of Christ would be humility

Micah 5:2

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Birth place would be Bethlehem

Zech 11:12-13

And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver.

13 *And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prized at of them.*

And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

Christ would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver

Zech 9:9

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

The manner of Christ's public entry

Mal 3:1

Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

Christ would be preceded by a fore-runner

David had to know the freeness of Salvation

Ps 32:1-2 *Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
2 Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity,
and in whose spirit there is no guile.*

The mercy seat was a type of Christ in the O.T. As a medium of mercy and communion w/God

Exod 25:21-22 *And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.
22 And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.*

You can't find the depths of God's mercy.

The Lambs were all pictures in the O.T.

John 1:29 *The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.*

John 1:36 *And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!*

Only blood atones or pays for the soul and ransoms from sin

Lev 17:11 *For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is **the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.***

2 Tim 1:5 *When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt **first** in **thy grandmother** Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.*

2 Tim 3:14-15 *But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them;*

15 *And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.*

The plan of Salvation was from the foundation of the Earth before man ever came on the scene.

Rev 13:8 *And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain **from the foundation** of the world.*

Eph 1:4 *According as he hath chosen us in him **before the foundation of the world**, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:*

Titus 1:2 *In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, **promised before the world began**;*

1 Pet 1:19-20 *But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: 20 Who verily was foreordained **before the foundation of the world**, but was manifest in these last times for you,*

Rev 17:8 *The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.*

Why would God's plan to cleanse from sin change?

Why would God's plan to give life change?

Is the only thing God said audibly to the O.T. Saints that which is recorded in the Bible?

What they were trusting in had not happened yet so they went to Paradise or were put on lay-a-way.

Acts 15:1-11 *And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.*

2 *When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.*

3 *And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.*

4 *And when they were come to Jerusalem, they were received of the church, and of the apostles and elders, and they declared all things that God had done with them.*

5 *But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, **That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses.***

6 *And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter.*

7 *And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe.*

8 *And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us;*

9 *And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.*

10 *Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, **which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?***

11 *But we believe that **through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.***
